Australian artist to showcase work...

THE latest work by Zimbabwean-born Australian artist Demi McLeod will be showcased next month.

The collection, entitled 'Gradual Instant', features 18 pieces on canvas, said organisers. McLeod's second formal solo exhibition in Bahrain will be held at the Capital Club in

Bahrain Financial Harbour from the second week of September until the end of the month. McLeod, a Bahrain resident for five years, is a full-time artist who formally studied art at the Regent Academy, London.
